

Regular Meeting

December 6, 2018

Present were Mayor Don Sincell, Councilmembers Fred Callis, Patrick Damon, Linda Fike, Jim Moore, and Pam Nelson at the Mountain Lake Park Town Hall.

Mayor Sincell called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Agenda Approval:

Public Comment:

Scott Collins said the code enforcement officer, Jarrett Mahoney, sent him a letter asking him to remove a basketball hoop from the White Pine Circle cul-de-sac where he lives. Mr. Collins would like to keep the basketball hoop where it is. The current ordinance prohibits nonessential obstructions on town rights-of-way. Mr. Mahoney presented a draft of a basketball hoop ordinance that would allow basketball hoops on rights-of-way under certain conditions. Mayor Sincell said he and the council members would review the proposed ordinance. And, until a decision regarding, or passage of, a basketball hoop ordinance, Mr. Collins would not have to take his hoop down.
